

## Lake Committee Meeting of July 20, 2022

### Old Business

On August 2 there will be a presentation to the Select Board by the Lake Committee regarding extending the hours of the CEO. Mike Guarino offered to draft a letter to the Select Board advising them of our intentions for our editing by Friday. We then discussed the list of bullet points that we wanted included in the letter.

### New Business:

Paul Thompson of 19 Carr Lane made a presentation about the activities in the Saghegan cove. There are many boats that raft up and party there. Last Sunday there were 8-10 boats. Jane and David Rohrback also complained about these rowdy activities and sometimes that these person even came ashore. There is a sandy beach and it is relatively near the public boat launch. Andrew Dallas and Ron Johnson also reiterated these nuisance activities.

The Board was sympathetic and asked questions and promised to get back to the complainers as to what remedies might be available from the game wardens and state police. Some of these observed activities were: beer pong, loud music, bad language and partying.

Guarino indicated that he had some contacts and would look into what could be done.

Andrew Dallas told us the Belgrade CEO had been involved and that he was doing a good job. And then he spoke about the property at 142 Woodland Camp Road owned by Elana York. This is the property where previously we heard that their mooring and docks were put in front of or infringing on a neighbor's property.

Dallas told us of the deforestation in the front of the property, soil being put down there and grass planted, installing granite steps and fence systems and clearing the water of fresh water clams. Richard Greenwald, our CEO had been advised of these violations and did issue a cease and desist order.

There being no further discussion the meeting was adjourned by a unanimous vote.
