Re: Temporary authorization to sign documents

In light of the current need to maintain appropriate social distances, Board Chairman Michael Barrett proposed a temporary policy authorizing the Town Manager to sign documents – notably the warrant – that have been expressly approved by the Board in a vote in a public meeting. That would extend to documents such as the abatement and supplemental the Board will consider during this meeting. The authorization would be rescinded once the Board can safely meet again in person.

Attached is the proposed policy.

Electronic signatures is another option. The executors of a document receive an electronic version of it and, after reviewing it, click in the appropriate space to add an electronic version of their signature. DocuSign, a leading vendor, offers a free trial; its normal cost is \$120 annually for a single administrator or \$15 per month. We may want to test this using the free trial and, if we find it beneficial, could buy either a monthly or year-long subscription. I have used this in the past and found it to be easy and convenient. It would also be an easy way to execute contracts with our vendors.

# Town of Belgrade Policy on the Delegation of Authority to Sign Board-approved Documents

The delegation of authority to sign documents formalizing a vote of the Belgrade Board of Selectpersons is hereby temporarily delegated to the Town Manager through the approval of the Selectpersons at their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, April 7, 2020. Such documents will include warrants and abatements/supplementals, but will extend to other actions expressly approved by the Board in a public meeting. This authorization will be rescinded once the current public health concern has abated and the Board can safely meet in person.

Re: Update of Town operations and public health concerns

As you know, on Wednesday we sent most of our staff home from facilities that had been closed to the public since March 16. That's in keeping with the governor's stay-at-home order, which extends through April 30. We will continue to direct citizens to our online services. I have made myself available to answer calls to the Town Office, and have publicized my cell number. We'll do our best to continue to be as responsive as we can to residents by phone and e-messages, even while curtailing services other than the Transfer Station and rescue services.

Last month, I spoke with Dr. Stephen Sears, a Belgrade resident who is an infectious disease specialist and a former State Epidemiologist. Dr. Sears has been called out of retirement to assist the Maine CDC during this public health crisis. His prediction the governor would likely soon issue a stay-at-home order proved prescient.

I also asked him if the minimum two-month duration of his episode is accurate. He believed it was. We are well on our way to meeting that benchmark. Dr. Sears surmised restrictions may well be in place into June.

All of that being the case, we are in a holding pattern ... and may be for at least another couple of months.

Re: Town Manager's report

Three plaques for **Spirit of America Award** recipients will cost about \$165. We propose using the Selectboard's special projects account to fund this cost.

With summer approaching, we should consider how to encourage orderly **parking in the Village**. Rather than passing an ordinance, I would propose street signs that read "Parking in designated areas only." Those alone may be enough to encourage people to park where we they should ... and to believe that admonition is backed by regulatory authority.

This time has given me a chance to pore over policy, starting with our **employment guidelines**. I will soon send you a red-lined version of proposed changes. Most are simply grammatical or meant to reflect how we operate. The most substantive change is to the **wage scale**. The proposed updated scale reflects what we currently pay staff and considers the findings of the MMA's most recent salary survey. I set the parameters of my analysis to towns with populations of 1,000 to 5,000. Please review this document when you can, and share your thoughts with me.

Lastly, as you might imagine, the public health episode will wreak some havoc on the **Town's revenue**. While we will eventually collect all of the excise tax due, our Recreation revenue will almost certainly fall short of the \$95,000 budgeted. We have not offered after-school care for three-plus weeks, and the prospect for summer camps is uncertain. While we can reduce the amounts in warrant articles, we cannot make substantive changes to offset that elsewhere. I would propose committing taxes in June at the same level as last year rather than reducing the municipal portion as previously planned. It's not beyond the realm we will need to seek to tap into the undesignated fund later in the year.

The Board chair would also like to talk about **donating Town iPads** to Piscataquis County schools.
