• Meeting Commencement:

• Meeting called to order by Dick at 4:00pm.

• Previous Meeting Minutes:

• Tom made a motion to accept December minutes, 2nd by Ted. All in favor.

• Current Dams Levels:

- Craig stated Great Pond was 246.8' (approx. 11" below full pond)
- Tom stated Long Pond was 238.1' (approx. at full pond due to recent heavy rains)
- Ted stated Salmon Lake was 277.1' (approx. 11" below full pond)
- Dick stated Snow Pond was 234.9' (approx. 6.5" below full pond)

• Lake Levels Strategy Discussion:

- Targeting 18" drawdown for winter storage levels. Difficulty with recent heavy rain.
- Essex Hydro substation outage upcoming. Essex has asked that we hold back water to assist and operators will do what they can while also considering rainfall later this week.

• New Maintenance:

• The Village Dam staff gauge has fallen off as a result of the deteriorating concrete and will be reinstalled once remediation work on the dam is complete.

• Old Business:

- Salmon Lake By-Pass Pipe Calibration:
 - No further discussion and the committee is content with 15 turns for 1cfs.
- Village Dam Concrete Remediation, Cofferdam and Project Update:
 - No new information/discussions to-date from Knowles Engineering.
- Installation of Salmon Dam Convex Traffic Mirror:
 - The committee reviewed the mirror received and planned the attachment method.
 - The mirror is expected to be installed in the next few weeks.
- Results of Army Corp., MEMA, Kennebec County EMA, DOT and Rep. Golden contacts for financial assistance with Village Dam remediation:
 - Dick reached out to these organizations for grants to help subsidize the cost of the dam remediation. Awaiting feedback – some communication with Kennebec County EMA and Rep. Golden's office.

- 2023 Proposed Dams Budget updates (meetings with Belgrade and Rome):
 - Dick expects he will update town budget committees Friday.

• New Business:

- Tom Bennett & Cameron McCafferty Committee Renewals:
 - All in favor.
- Operation update on debris screen at Salmon Lake Dam (safety line needed?):
 - Valve is currently closed as operators are ensuring the bottom of the dam does not freeze up while water levels are still fluctuating so much due to recent rains.
- Installation of snowmobile crossing signage, Belgrade Town Office, etc.
 - Warnings have been posted & will put on town sign as well. Ice is not currently safe and subject to further stress with continued water level fluctuation from recent rains.
