Anthony,

I drove all of these roads yesterday and agree with the choices. Suggest a table listing target roads with this info to prepare for next week's discussion:

- Major preparation requirements this year & next spring: trees, ditches, raised rocks, culverts, etc. (maintenance budgets);
- Length, regrind?, pavement width?, pavement coats (base & wear)?, compacted thicknesses and asphalt mix recipe for each (two spec choices?);
- Consider two general paving specs: (1) roads subject to heavier loads and/or frequent travel (2) roads subject to lighter use;
- Estimate mixed asphalt tons required for each road, and in total (largest single cost factor);
- Consider adding East-West Road and Damren Road for paving;
- Consider road paving priorities in case bids come in above budget targets and town approval;
- Consider discussion with Sidney re paving Mills Road. Belgrade's short portion serves two houses, Sidney's serves 18 +/-. Sidney's plow enters over Belgrade's connection to Rt. 27 anyway.

Roads Committee, attached is an updated spreadsheet of which roads were paved when. It's not complete (some years, the town appropriated money for paving without designating which roads), but it's closer than when we began researching this a couple of weeks ago. I consulted with Maurice and talked with Jason, and here's what the Road Commissioner is proposing at this point that we do:

- Pave the **Guptill Road**, which may currently be the worst road in town.
- Pave **Depot Road** and then continue up **Minot Hill Road**. That would yield 2.25 miles of what is essentially a straight shot of paving. Maurice said if Minot Hill wasn't paved in 2022, it would need to be included in the subsequent paving package. He and Jason agree it would be more efficient/economical to pair that road with the Depot Road.
- Look at paving the portion of **Old Route 27** that was not paved in 2013 and the **Mills Road**

(which, incidentally, Sidney plows, despite it being a Belgrade Road).

- Look at paving Hulin Road, Red Oak Lodge Road, School Street and Lakeview Drive. We would need to be mindful of paving only the portions of Red Oak Lodge and Lakeshore that belong to the town; at a certain point on each road, the paving stops and they become private roads.
- If we need to flesh out the paving program to reach an approximate cost of \$1.2 million, we could also consider **Foster Point Road** and **Grandview Drive**.

On the matter of cost, I would recommend we seek to maintain the \$400,000 per year of debt service that the Town currently carries. That would prevent a yoyoing of costs and, subsequently, of the mil rate. I think we'd rather maintain the mil rate rather than there being big dips that would later necessitate spikes. But all of this will be good fodder for the next Roads Committee meeting at **6 p.m. on Tuesday, May 25**, on Zoom at <u>https://us02web.zoom.us/j/84988812792</u>.
